Wedding structure

Rubystrings can play at your wedding ceremony, reception, or both.

Ceremony

There are usually three important musical moments during a wedding ceremony: the **Processional**, the **Signing of the Register** and the **Recessional**.

Processional

Pre-ceremony

Rubystrings usually provides 15 minutes of pre-ceremony music to set the scene and entertain guests upon arrival. Unless you have particular music requests, you can leave this part up to us. We will perform elegant, light classical music.

Reception

At the Reception, music will typically accompany guests arriving, drinks, canapés and the sit-down dinner from entrée to dessert.

We will play a selection of music from our **<u>handy repertoire pdf</u>**. Unless you have particular requests, you can leave the music up to us.

Player requirements

- Each musician will need an armless chair.
- If your wedding is outdoors, Rubystrings players will need protection from the weather (be it rain, hail or shine) an umbrella or gazebo or verandah, etc.
- For bookings longer than 1 hour, the players will require 10 minutes break for every hour, and drinking water.
- If the booking is longer than 3 hours, each musician will need a meal.
